

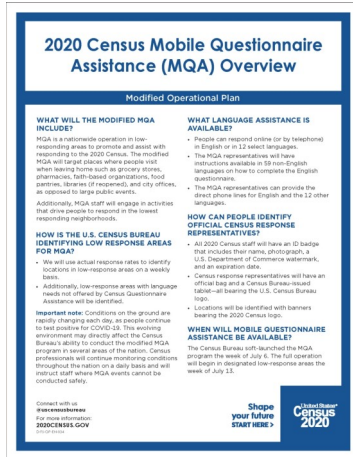

## Census Bureau Launches Mobile Questionnaire Assistance to Help People Respond Online to the 2020 Census: Census Response Representatives to Visit Low-Responding Areas

More than 3,000 U.S. Census Bureau staff will begin going into communities with the lowest 2020 Census response rates to encourage and assist people with responding on their own to the 2020 Census. This operation, known as the Mobile Questionnaire Assistance (MQA) program, is a separate activity from census takers going door to door to count households that have not yet responded. MQA is part of the Census Bureau's final push to encourage people to complete the 2020 Census before the Nonresponse Followup (NRFU) operation begins nationwide on August 11. ## Response Rate Fun Facts (July 13)

- All 50 states, District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico had a daily total self-response rate less than 0.1 percent
- Utah had the highest cumulative Internet self-response rate of 60.5 percent, followed by Minnesota and Washington
- Utah was second with the highest cumulative total self-response for all Western states at 66.4 percent, behind Washington and ahead of Idaho
- Los Alamos County, NM is the top West County by area with 80.7 percent self-response rate
